Timing transponders also will be handed out together with start numbers and must be returned immediately after the race to the Race Permanence. If a transponder is not returned a $130 \in$ penalty will be applicable per transponder.

5. RACE SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

1.1 The 2018 UEC MTB Marathon European Championships are organized by the Union Européenne de Cyclisme (UEC) in cooperation with the team ASD Polisportiva Trivium Spilimbergo and the Italian Cycling Federation.

- 1.2 The event will be organized in accordance with rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.
- 1.3 The UEC MTB Marathon European Championships consist of the following races: MTB Marathon (XCM) on the 22 April 2018

ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF THE EVENT

2.1 The event is open to athletes in following categories:

✓ MTB Marathon	Men Elite
✓ MTB Marathon	Women Elite
✓ MTB Marathon	Masters Men 30-34 / 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 / 50-54 55-59 / 60-64 / 65-69 / 70/74 / 75+
✓ MTB Marathon	Masters Women 30-34 / 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 50-54 / 55-59 / 60+





- 2.2 It is entered on the UCI calendar as a Continental Championships event (UCI CC).
- 2.3 The following final classifications will be produced:

1.Men Elite* 2.Women Elite* 3.all masters categories*

*The 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony.

<u>Results for the UCI</u>: One combined results for WomenElite and Women Masters - based on time. One combined results for MenElite and Men Masters - based on time.

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

3.1 Participation – NATIONAL TEAMS (Elite riders only)

National Federations may enter the following riders per Championship free of charge:

Women Elite – max. 6 riders Men Elite – max. 6 riders

The National Federations have to register their riders directly on the UEC website (www.uec.ch).

Deadline for the registrations (riders, staff and NF Official Delegates) - 12 April 2018 (24:00 CET)

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

3.2 Participation – OTHER RIDERS

In accordance with the UCI regulations, the participation is open for <u>European</u> riders only with an annual licence issued by a National Federation affiliated to the UCI.

Registrations have to be done using the organiser's registration form.

The registration form is available in our website and must be entirely completed <u>(also indicating the complete UCI code)</u> and accompanied by receipt of the bank transfer. Direct link: Subscribe online https://www.mysdam.net Participants' phone number and/or E-mail address are necessary to the organizer to confirm the registration of the participant or group. The registration fee is: **Euro 55,00** for Marathon race (km 103.9) by **31.03.2018 at midnight**. From 1st April 2018 Euro 60 for Marathon race (km 103.9).

Registrations must be sent to the organization until Wednesday 18th APRIL 2018 at midnight.

ARTICLE 4. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

The following UCI Regulations will be applicable:

4.2.044

No rider may turn back on the course to reach a feed/technical assistance zone. Any rider doing so is disqualified. Only within the feed/technical assistance zone itself, a rider may turn back without obstructing other competitors

4.2.045

Technical assistance during a race is permitted subject to the conditions below.

4.2.046

Authorised technical assistance during a race consists of repairs to or the replacement of any part of the bicycle other than the frame.

Bike changes are not permitted and the rider must cross the finishing line with the same handlebar number plate that he/she had at the start.

4.2.047

Technical assistance can only be given in the feed/technical assistance zones.

4.2.048

Spare equipment and tools for repairs must be kept in these zones. Repairs and equipment changes can be carried out by the rider himself or with the help of a teammate, team mechanic or neutral technical assistance.

Small items such as an inner tube or a small tool may be handed up from the feed/technical assistance zones.

4.2.049

In addition to technical assistance in feed zones, technical assistance is permitted outside these zones only between riders who are members of the same UCI ELITE MTB team, UCI MTB team or of the same national team.

During the European championships, it is only authorised between riders of the same national team.

Riders may carry tools and spare parts provided that these do not involve any danger to the rider himself or the other competitors.

ARTICLE 6. AWARDS CEREMONIES

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony, any interviews organized and the press conference.

Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing.

Riders must present themselves at the podium in a maximum of 10 minutes after crossing the finish line.





ARTICLE 7. AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY

Jersey and medals

Every European Championship will be awarded with:

The 1st place: Champion(s) jersey and Gold medal The 2nd place: Silver medal The 3rd place: Bronze medal

The prize money will be transferred by the UEC directly to the concerned National Federations.

ARTICLE 8. ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations and the specific Italian Antidoping laws are entirely applicable to the event.

ARTICLE 9. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 10. RESPONSIBILITIES

The organizers and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organizers and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
