

Introduction

During the 2019 European Championships in Valmiera in Latvia the UEC will organise a BMX time trial test event in order to explore new events. UEC limits the participation of nations to a maximum of 5. All federations are invited to send their registrations for the BMX Time trial event. The UEC BMX Commission will be responsible to select the participating teams.

Regulations

1. General

A BMX Time trial is a race against the clock with teams of riders of the same nationality and same gender. Each federation can register maximum 1 team per category during Registration.

The BMX Team Time Trial competition is open to National Teams only. One participating Nation can be represented by one participating team per category maximum. The 2019 BMX Time Trial test event is held on Sunday 14 July 2019.

2. Competition categories

Within the BMX Team Time Trial competition, the categories are as follows:

- Men Elite, aged 17 and over;
- Women Elite, aged 17 and over.

3. Participation

A team of riders consists of 3 men, or 3 women in the categories mentioned above.

4. Competition Format

In a BMX Team Time Trial event both riders of a team will start at the same time. The finishing time shall be taken on the 2nd rider crossing the finishing line.

At the end of a BMX Team Time Trial competition, a final team classification is made that defines the final results for each participating category

In case of a tie between teams UCI ranking will determine the end result.
