1. Introduction

The host club TSV Braunschardt, the Organisation Comitee, the city of Weiterstadt and all our partners welcome you all to the 5th and 6th Round of the 2016 European Cup in Weiterstadt, Germany from June 10th to June 12th 2016.

BMX-racing is tradition in Weiterstadt and it has a huge role in the sports and cultural environment of the city. It all began in the year 1982. A couple of BMX enthusiasts teamed up to practice and go to races together. But without a BMX track, practicing is very difficult. Therefore, some families joined to found the BMX club that still exists today. Shortly afterwards, in 1983, they joined the sports club TSV Braunschardt 1889 e.V. A BMX track could soon be built. In 1984 the young BMX club already hosted a German Championship on the brand new track. This was the acid test for an even bigger project, a European Championship which was planned for the year 1986. This big event was successfully realized. Over 1200 BMX riders came to Weiterstadt for this race. Since then, the Weiterstadt BMX-Club was the host of many national and international races. After the European Championship and European Cup races in 1986, 2008, 2010, and 2013 the upcoming race will be the fifth international race in Weiterstadt.

4. Location

Weiterstadt is located right in the middle of the Rhein Main district. Via the Autobahn A5 you can easily reach Frankfurt, Mannheim and Heidelberg.

The BMX-track is located in Weiterstadt which is about 10 minutes away from Darmstadt and 20 minutes away from Frankfurt.

Coming from Autobahn A5 take the exit on interchange 25 to B42 towards Weiterstadt West. Follow the BMX signs from that point on.

Coming from Autobahn A67 take the exit Büttelborn towards Weiterstadt. Follow the BMX signs from that point on.

The drive from both Autobahn exits take only a few minutes.





5. Rules

The UEC BMX European Cup 2016 is open to any rider from any country with a national license, in compliance with the UCI regulations. There is no limit on the number of riders from one country that can be registered. The race will be run under the UEC 2016 regulations. Championship riders can score UCI points for their country ranking.

PLEASE BEWARE: If there are more than 256 riders in a category, they will only ride 2 Moto's instead of 3. All other categories will ride 3 heats.

6. Registration deadline for riders

All registrations & payments for riders must be made through your own national BMX federation. This ensures that registrations & payments are coordinated.

9. Classes

UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP

Championship classes:

- Men Elite Male riders 19 years and older
- Women Elite Female riders 19 years and older
- Men Junior Male Riders 17 and 18 years old
- Women Junior Female riders 17 and 18 years old

Challenge classes:

- Boys: 7, 8, 9, 10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16
(minimum age 7 years old) – combined classes if less than 5 riders
- Girls: 7, 8, 9, 10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16
(minimum age 7 years old) – combined classes if less than 5 riders
- Men: 17/24, Men 25+
- Women 17+
- Cruisers: 17/29, 30/39, 40/44, 45+
- Cruiser Women: 17 + (1 combined classes)

10. Number plates and Side Plates

The organization will NOT provide number plates and side plates. Riders have to bring their own and apply them according the rules.

11. Welcome Desk

The Welcome Desk is the central location where riders, visitors, and the crew can pick up their entrance tickets (for your car as well as for yourself).

The Welcome Desk is in the white office container behind the track entrance. Follow event signs for the “Welcome Desk”.

12. Trophies and Prize money

Only the Challenge & Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obliged to attend the award ceremony. The other riders (4th-8th place) can pick up their trophy at the the welcome desk, on presentation of their UCI license. All the prize money that has not been collected right after the podium ceremony will not be given on a later moment.

For the Championship Classes:

Cups for places 1 to 3 and prize money distributed as shown below for each round. **Prize money can be collected from the Welcome Desk Only on presentation of UCI licence.**

14. Team Pitlane

The price for a team area place for UEC-registered teams is € 150,- (6x3m) and non-registered teams is € 200,- (6x3m).

UEC registration will be checked by the information provided by the UEC.

The UEC-registered teams are the closest to the track. Team tents are only permitted at the team area. There is one parking spot per team tent available on the parking area near the team area.

Every UEC registered team has received before round 1 & 2 at Zolder a UEC pass for the whole 2016.

This pass will permit entrance to team manager area and Team manager meeting.

In Weiterstadt every UEC registered team will receive 2 entry bracelets.

The NON UEC registered teams will also receive 2 entry bracelets, but they have no access to the Team Managers Zone.

Please book and pay before the 1st June 2016 or no space guaranteed.

15. Ticket prices

At the Registers:

- One-day ticket Saturday: €15
- One-day ticket Sunday: €15
- Weekend ticket: €20

Children below the age of 6 do not have pay entrance fee on presentation of ID card.

Riders who enter the tournament do not have to pay an entrance fee. They get an entrance bracelet with their 'Riders' envelope'.





Due to security reasons bikes are not prohibited in the spectator area.

16. Camping

There will be a camping site very close to the track (around 300m by foot). The camping site is open from Thursday, 9th June 6 pm to Monday 13th June 2016 12 pm.

Showers, fresh water supply, toilettes, and a dump for chemical toilettes are near the campground. Supermarkets, restaurants, bakeries are available within a distance of 500m.

Unfortunately, we cannot supply electricity.

- The campground is about 300m away from the BMX-Track
- Flat fee from Thursday, 9th June 6 pm to Monday 13th June 12 pm 2016: €50 for each camping lot - when paying in advance / €60 when paying on the arrival.
- The size of each camping lot is 8m x 6m
- Flat fee has to be paid cash on the arrival
