

Rounds 1 & 2: Verona (ITA)

Rounds 3 & 4: Zolder (BEL)

Rounds 5 & 6: Råde (NOR)

Rounds 7 & 8: Sarrians (FRA)

Rounds 9 & 10: Peer (BEL)

General:

The 2019 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist of 10 rounds. All races count.

All teams have to register through UEC, **deadline 11th March 2019**, in order to take part in the 2019 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition. The registration form is published on the website www.uec.ch

The overall award ceremony will be held in Peer (BEL) with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX Commission will award 3 trophies to the 3 first teams and one medal to each rider of the team:

- **Gold medal for 1st team of the 2019 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking**
- **Silver medal for 2nd team of the 2019 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking**
- **Bronze medal for 3rd team of the 2019 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking**

Rules :

- Teams wanting to participate in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition must register a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders, aged 13 years and over.
- National Championship teams will also be allowed to participate in the team ranking. National Championships teams will be ranked separately from the regular mixed teams. The team consists of a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders in the Championships categories.
- Each team pays a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline 11th March 2019) – UEC fee € 200,-.
- UEC teams have to confirm their 4 rider participation before each event at riders' registration, according to the time schedule. Teams have to fill-in the team Entry form before each event and hand in the form at rider's registration. The 2019 entry form can be downloaded from the website www.uec.ch.
- Riders from all classes are welcome to enter the regular UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition: Challenge (20 & 24') and Championship.
- Minimum age for team riders to register is 13 years and over.

- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach at the event.
- If a rider is not able to race or not racing at all on Sunday, the team coach can enter a new rider for the Sunday competition. This must be done before the start of the block 1 motos on Sunday morning.
- Points will be given according to European official grid.
- UEC Teams only receive team passes for an event when they enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- A team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.
- UEC Teams that do not enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as any other team without UEC registration.

The Organizer has to provide to UEC teams registered for a UEC BMX European Cup event:

- Spaces for team tents, as close as possible to the track, of 6 x 3 m for each team registered for that specific race, at the cost of a maximum of € 150;
- A team space will not automatically be assigned to a UEC Team. A UEC team also has to register for the team space with the organiser of a UEC BMX European Cup event;
- Team passes as indicated below when entered in the events Team Competition;
- Promote the name of the Team during races as listed on the moto sheets.

UEC Team Passes:

Each UEC Team receives the following passes when they enter an event of the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition:

1x pass type A - with the following rights:

- Free entry to track
- Entry to staging
- Entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
- Entry to Team manager meeting
- Entry to Team manager area

This team pass will be provided to team managers of UEC Teams when they hand in their team registration form for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition.

Other teams

The Organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of a minimum of € 200.

These teams receive the following passes at an event from the organiser.

- 1x pass type C - with the following rights:
 - Free entry to track

Team area

UEC asks organisers to make a placement plan for the team area, to make it easy for riders to go to staging from the team area and from the finish line back to the team area.

Please keep the following order into account when making a team area plan:

- 1st priority and less close to staging: National Championship teams
- 2nd priority and closest to staging: UEC registered teams
- 3rd priority and farthest from staging: all other teams that rented a team space
