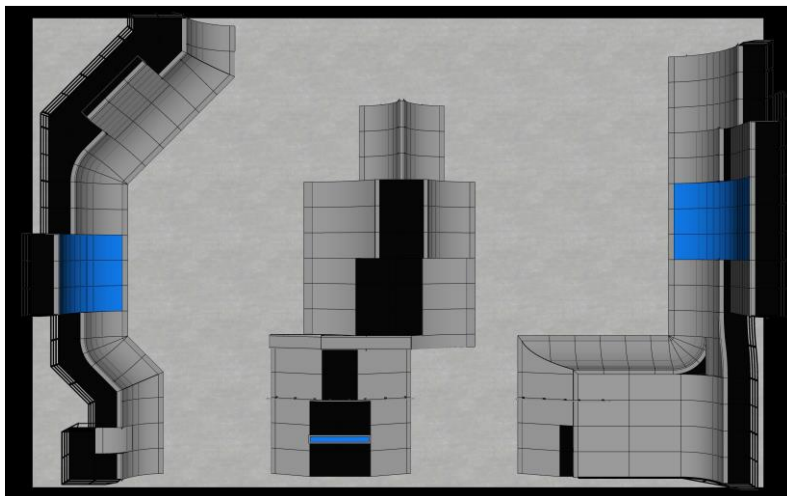

UCI RULES

RIDERS CATEGORIES

- Men categories: Men Elite (aged 15 and over)
- Women categories: Women Elite (aged 15 and over)

SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

In accordance with UCI regulations only European riders can participate in European Championships. All riders must hold a national license issued by an UCI affiliated federation.

The maximum number in each category is 30 riders per category.

Selection procedure before the first deadline

Every European Federation can register two riders in each category before the first registration deadline.

Each federation can register a maximum of

- 2 Men Elite
- 2 Women Elite

Selection procedure before the second deadline

If spots are still available, the highest ranked nations will have an opportunity to take an extra available spot in each category. Starting with the highest ranked nation, a nation has the chance to take another until the total spots of 30 are taken, each country has a maximum of 3 quota.

COMPETITION FORMAT

6bis.6.003 A BMX Freestyle Competition for each category may be composed of the phases (Qualification, Semi-final or Final) described below, and within each phase, a number of heats.

For Park Competitions, a heat is a group which comprises 2 to 5 riders.

The combination of phases and heats (if applicable) for a category depends on the number of entries and is found in the following table.

Number of entries	Competition phases	Qualification rule	Number of heats
5-8 entries	2 phases: Qualification x 1 Finals x 1	Top 4 in Qualification advance to Final	Qualification: as below 1 heat of 4 in Final
9 - 15 entries	2 phases: Qualification x 1 Finals x 1	Top 8 in Qualification advance to Final	Qualification: as below 1 heats of 8 in Final
16 - 31 entries	2 phases: Qualification x 1 Finals x 1	Top 12 in Qualification advance to Final	Qualification: as below 2 heats of 6 in Final

Number of heats

The number of heats in each round is found in the table above. For the Qualification phase, the number of heats should be chosen such that as many heats as possible have 4 riders.

6bis.6.004 A run is the individual unit of Competition in a BMX Freestyle Event, during which a rider performs a routine consisting of various tricks, which is evaluated by the judges.

PARK COMPETITIONS

At all phases of the Competition, within each heat, each rider shall do 2 runs.

In general, riders do their first run in the start order defined in article 6bis.6.005. Once the final rider in the order within each heat has taken their first run, the riders will do their second run in the same order.

USE OF DRONES

Without prejudice to stricter requirements according to the national legislation, the use of drones is prohibited above the course and within 10 meters from the course. Moreover, the user must ensure the drone at no time puts the security of riders, followers and spectators at risk.

REGISTRATION AND RIDERS' CONFIRMATION

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Registration in the Men Elite and Women Elite categories shall be done by pre-registration only. Once the pre-registration deadline has passed, no further entries shall be accepted.

The online registration system will open: **Monday, 19 August 2024 (09:00 CET)**
First deadline to claim 2 spots: **Friday 30 August 2024 (23:59 CET)**

Second deadline: Federations will be contacted if they are allowed to send a 3rd rider.
Pre-Registration closes **Friday, 6 September 2024 (23:59 CET)**

REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

A valid cycling license, as defined in Part I of the UCI Regulations will be required and must be presented at riders confirmation to check their identity.

An identity card or passport is also mandatory. Once all the terms of the registration are completed, the organization will give riders a wristband allowing them to enter the competition area.

It is imperative that all the riders keep their band throughout the event, otherwise the access to the park will be denied. A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non-suspended license holder cannot be established in any other manner may not start and may not figure in the classification of the event.

Entry in the competition implies agreement with the event schedule, regulations and all provisions of the Technical Guide.

TRAINING

Training groups will be set up following the last update of the UCI Individual Ranking. In case of a deleted flight, luggage delay, sickness or any other reason that prevents you to train in the group in which you are assigned, please contact us.

Riders must be completely registered before beginning their first practice; they are not allowed in the competition venue until they are completely registered.

PRIZE MONEY

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony and any interviews organised.

The award ceremony will take place just after the end of the final, be sure to stay on the park for the announcement of the final results.

ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The antidoping test will be conducted by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The antidoping tests will take place in Sculoa Media Cadenazzo

PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The organiser and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organiser and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.
