

General:

The 2025 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist of 12 rounds. All rounds count.

Rounds 1 & 2: Verona (ITA)
Rounds 3 & 4: Zolder (BEL)
Rounds 5 & 6: Lempdes (FRA)
Rounds 7 & 8: Tiel (NED)
Rounds 9 & 10: Angelholm (SWE)
Rounds 11 & 12: Benátky nad Jizerou (CZE)

All teams have to register through UEC, deadline 1st March 2025, in order to take part in the 2025 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition.

The registration form is published on the website www.uec.ch.

The UEC BMX Commission will award Prizemoney to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

The overall award ceremony will be held with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

Registration

- o Teams wanting to participate in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition must register a minimum of 5 riders and a maximum of 10 riders, aged 13 years and over.
- o National teams are allowed to participate in the team ranking.
- Each team pays a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline 15th February 2025) – UEC fee € 500,-.
- Riders from categories 13 years and over are welcome to enter the regular UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition: Challenge riders 20", Challenge Cruisers, and Championship riders.
- Minimum age for team riders to register is 13 years.





- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach at the event.
- If a rider is competing in both 20" and 24" categories must be registered 2-times on the team registration form.

Team confirmation

- UEC teams have to confirm their 4 riders participation before each event at UEC Team confirmation, indicated in the time schedule.
- A team manager can enter 4 riders for the 1st day of the Competition, and 4 different riders for the 2nd day of the competition. This can only be done on Friday during UEC Team confirmation.
- If a rider is not able to race or not racing at all on day 2, the team manager can enter a new rider for the 2nd day of competition. This must be done before the start of the heats on Day 2.

Competition

- o Points will be given according to the UEC Points table.
- Riders earn double points for the UEC Team ranking at the last 2 rounds of the 2025
 UEC BMX European Cup.
- Riders of combined categories receive ranking points according the UEC Points table for the end result of the combined category, not the split category result.
- o In case a (combined or regular) category races only motos, these riders receive ranking points based upon the final result of that (combined or regular) category.

Accreditation

- Each registered UEC Team receives 1 accreditation pass for the team manager per event when they enter their team for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition.
- The accreditation of a UEC BMX team manager is only valid during the UEC BMX European Cup, not during the European Championships.
- UEC Teams accreditation is only valid for an event when the team registers 4 riders for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at that event.





o Accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team manager rights

- o A team manager is accredited with 1 accreditation pass the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. UEC Team manager accreditation has the following rights:
 - Free entry to track
 - Free entry to staging (same rights as Chef d'Equipe)
 - Free entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
 - Free entry to Team manager meeting
 - o Free entry to Team manager area

Team space

- o A team tent space will not automatically be assigned to a UEC Team. A UEC team must register for the team tent space directly with the organiser of a UEC event.
- UEC Teams that do not enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as non UEC teams.
- A UEC registered team can rent a team tent space at the event of 6 x 3 m, at the cost of a maximum of € 150,00. Any additional space is also at the cost of € 150,00.

Team area

UEC asks organisers to make a placement plan for the team area, to make it easy for riders to go to staging from the team area and from the finish line back to the team area.

Non UEC teams

The Organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of a minimum of € 200,00.
