1. INTRODUCTION

Maris Strombergs Agency and the city Valmiera are very proud to welcome you to the BMX track, inspired by the great achievements of two-times Olympic gold medalist Maris Strombergs.

2. TRACK DETAILS

The track is 330 meters long, with two starting hills (8 and 5 meters high) and three start gates (8, 5 and 3 metres high). BMX track configuration has been developed by "PRO TRACKS" – experienced developers of several Olympic BMX tracks.



3. THE CITY OF VALMIERA

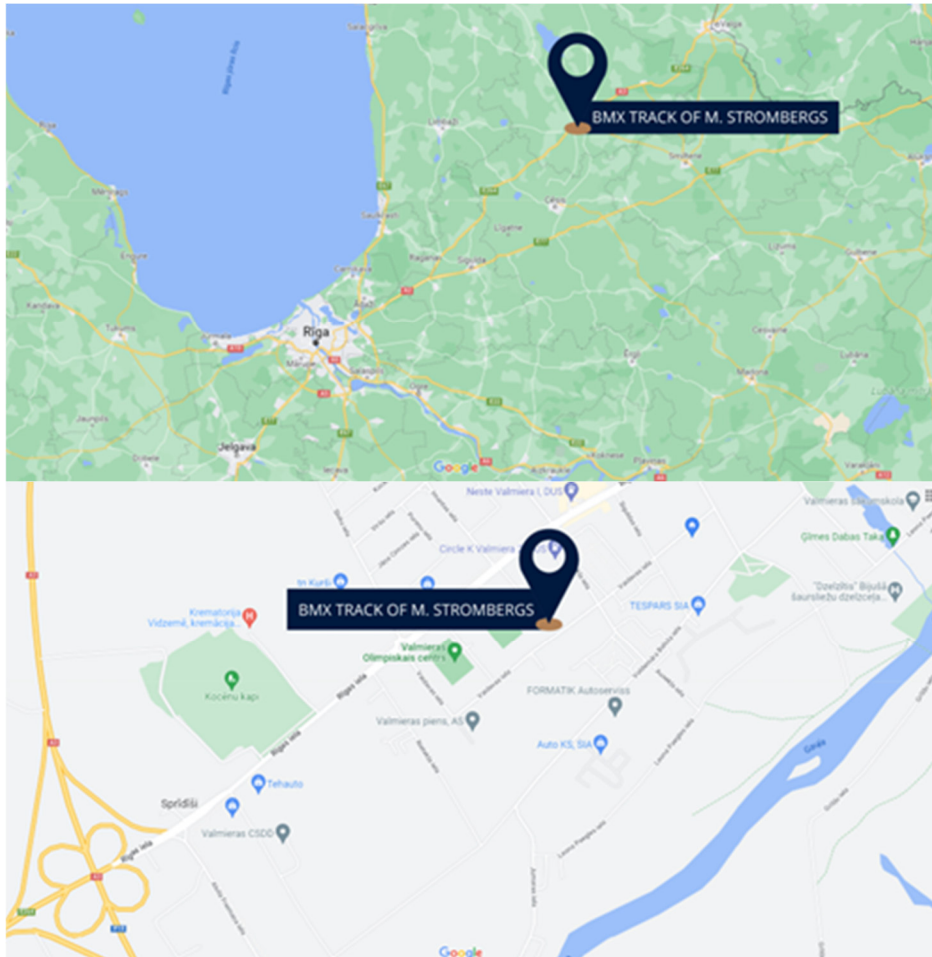

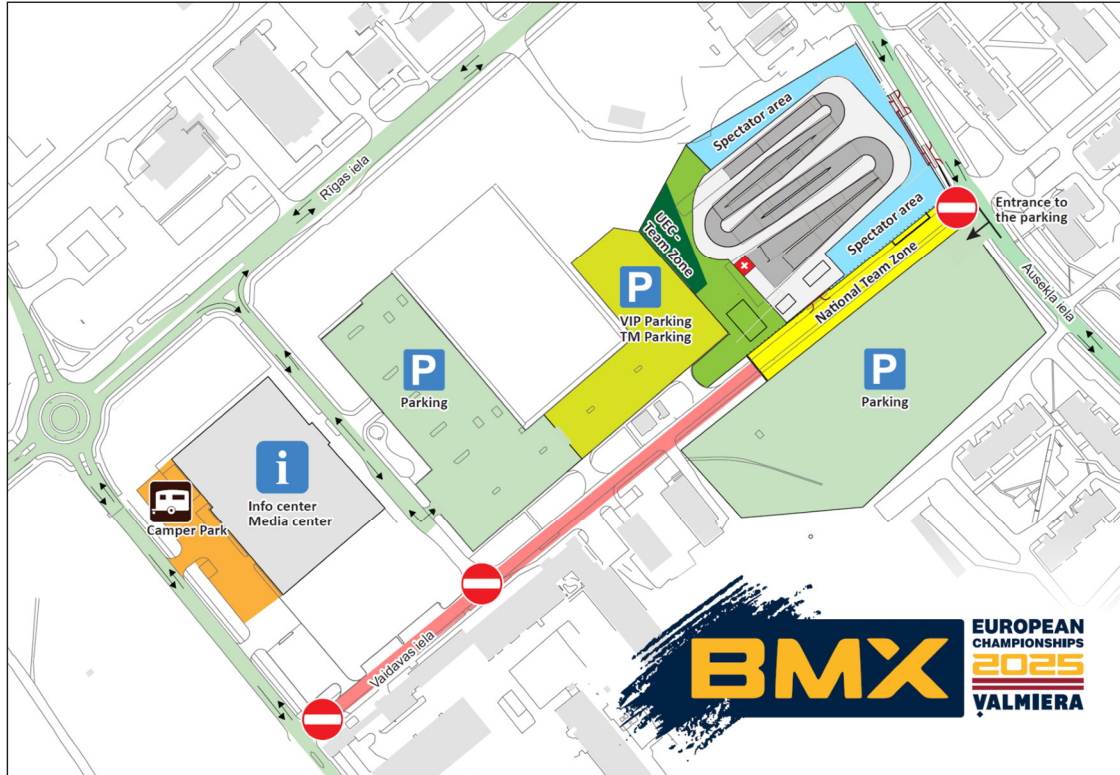
By car

8. RIDER CATEGORIES

In accordance with the UCI rules only European riders can participate in a CC race.
All riders (Challenge and Championship) must hold a national license issued by an UCI affiliated Federation.

In order for a category to be held, at least nine riders must be pre-registered in that category.

If less than nine riders are entered in a challenge category following the cancellation, the category will be combined according to UCI rules.

In the case that any under-subscribed category cannot be combined according to these rules, this category shall not be run. The federations concerned will be informed of the combination class(es) as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

BMX European Challenge classes

Only European riders allowed, minimum license age 8 years old.

All challenge classes will be run on one or the other day according to time schedule.

9. REGISTRATION AND RIDER'S CONFIRMATION

Participation

Championship classes

Each Federation is allowed to enter a maximum number of 16 riders in each championship classes.

Challenge classes

Each Federation is allowed to enter a maximum number of 16 riders in all challenge classes, for the host country it is allowed to enter 32 riders in all challenge classes.

Registration Participants

Federations can register riders for the UEC BMX Racing European Championships through the registration platform paying the applicable fees directly through the registration platform.

Riders confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation at the Welcome centre on Tuesday evening to confirm their rider's participation for the event and receive number plates and accreditation (see programme).

Registration fees

The 2025 registration fees, excluding administration fee and bank costs are the following:

Transponders

All riders in the classes (15, 16, Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC at riders confirmation. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager. Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race.

If a rider fails to return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100.- per transponder to the federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next UEC BMX European Cup round until the invoice is paid.

10. RULES

All riders, coaches, parents, commissaires, personnel and visitors must respect rules implemented on the venue by the organiser.

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments.

The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event (<https://results.jstiming.com>)

Event format

For all Challenge categories (except the categories 15, 16 year) scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to the UCI BMX Rulebook.

For Challenge 15, 16 years, and Championship categories the UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to the UCI BMX Rulebook

- For a category to be held, at least 13 riders must be registered and confirmed in that category following rider's confirmation. If less than 13 riders are entered in a category following riders' confirmation, the riders will be combined with the category of the same gender, following Article 6.3.005 bis of the UCI Rulebook.
- All riders in the categories 15, 16, Junior, U23 and Elite require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Championships.

Rider's equipment

All riders receive a UEC number plate and side plate at rider confirmation. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.

All challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.

All Championship rider must wear their National Jersey with career number if they have one.

Article 1.3.059: the wearing of National Team clothing shall be mandatory :

- At World Championships
- At Continental Championships
- For the riders of a National team
- During Olympic and Paralympic games, in accordance with the IOC and NOC Regulations.

The Continental and National Champions must comply with this rules and wear their national team clothing while participating in the events cited here before.

Article 1.3.071: Without prejudice to relevant provisions but applicable for all the disciplines, should various provisions requiring the wearing of different jerseys apply to the same rider, the order of priority shall be as follows:

1. the leader's jerseys on the stage race
2. the world champion's jersey
3. the leader's jersey of the cup, series or UCI classification
4. the continental champion's jersey
5. the national champion's jersey
6. the national jersey

In accordance with the last amendments of the UCI rules the World Champions must wear their rainbow jersey.

In case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate can make changes to the time schedule.

Please note: In the event the European Championships cannot take place for unpredictable circumstances (weather conditions, pandemic, etc.), the UEC cannot be responsible. Therefore, registration fees cannot be refunded.

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be held as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team; max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

11. ACCREDITATION

Athletes

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

Chef d'Equipe

Each Federation which registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (National Team Manager) to represent the interests of all its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each riders as per the preregistration riders list, on the scheduled day and times of registration

National Challenge Team

A Chef d'Equipe and his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Members of the country delegations will receive accreditation at all UEC events according to the following schedule if they register their staff. Please send an email with names and function to j.polkamp@uec.ch before the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team Manager and Assistants must present a license from the Federation. UEC will check the registration of the staff and then they will be given the accreditation. Without a registration UEC will not give out accreditation.

Each National Championships Team/UCI Team must register their Staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members. Please send an email to j.polkamp@uec.ch before the event. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the Instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

UCI BMX teams have the same rights as National teams.

UEC Teams

2025 UEC BMX Teams do not receive accreditation for the UEC BMX European Championships.

Personal BMX coaches

The Organiser offers Coach Accreditation at a fee of €150 per accreditation for the whole event, paying with cash money in the Welcome Centre during opening hours.

12. PRIZE MONEY , MEDALS, JERSEY AND TROPHIES

The winner of the 12 Championship categories (mentioned above) receive an official UEC Championships jersey and a gold medal. Number 2 and 3 receive a silver and bronze medals.

Price money will be awarded according to the price money schedule below, The UEC will proceed to the payment on the price money by the middle of October 2025 through the riders' National Cycling Federation.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Challenge Categories

Trophies are available for the finalists of all classes of the Continental Championship race for Challenge classes. Trophies place 4th to 8th place in the final will be awarded immediately at the finish line. Challenge riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obliged to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bike, for media purposes.

13. TEAM AREA

Procedure

Team area is located on street which would be closed for traffic and is located near the staging area and it's subject to prior mandatory booking at the rate of:

- UEC 2025 registered Team space (see Area A on site map) € 150 for a space 3x6 (18 m²)
- Non-registered teams Team space (see Area A on site map) € 200 for a space 3x6 (18 m²)
- National Team area and tent with 1 table, 6 chairs, 1 entry ticket (see Area B on site map) € 300 for 3x6 (18 m²)
- Nation Team area space and tent with 1 table, 6 chairs, 1 entry ticket, 1 car space next to the tent (see Area B on site map) € 500 for 5x5 (25 m²)

TEAM AREA – Reservation information and payment

You can make a reservation starting from 01/05/2025 till 06/06/2025 on organisers' website www.bmrxvalmiera.lv . Reservation must be made before the arrival in Valmiera accompanied by the payment made online, using the reservation link.

TEAM AREA - Rules

- At the arrival follow the indications for the Welcome Centre. At the desk you can receive the PASS to enter in the Team area and a PASS for parking (the organiser needs the car/van plate number). It will be necessary to show a copy of the payment.
- Arriving will be permitted from July 8, 2025.
- Teams must leave on July 14, 2025.
- Team area will be closed one hour after the races/practice end.
- The organiser will assign space locations.

17. LIVESTREAM

The UEC BMX European Challenge events are broadcasted live on the UEC website: www.uec.ch.
The UEC BMX European Championships events are broadcasted live by EUROVISION. TV takers are available one week before the event on UEC website.

18. PARKING

For teams: 1 parking, no admission fee (*see the map of the event*).

For officials: 1 parking, no admission fee (*see the map of the event*).

For spectators: A free parking place is located 1min walk from the track. And about 50m from the track there is another free parking located.

19. CATERING

There will be several catering stands, where you can buy hot and cold food and drinks.

20. SHOPS

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Championships and Challenge.

The price is showed below:

- € 450 for a space 12x6m (72 m²),
- € 250 for a space 6x6m (36 m²),
- € 150 for a space 3x6m (28 m²),
- € 100 for a space 3x3m (9 m²).

21. PRESS

Throughout the event there will be a dedicated work area for journalists and general press in the sports arena on the track area. Riders can be interviewed from this location.

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

Deadline Press Accreditation 7 July 2025

During the UEC BMX European Championships events Press accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC Press Officer / deputy. It's mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution. A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC press officer or his / her deputy.
- During the events, five yellow Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a orange BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

Drones

- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

22. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room near staging area.

Vidzeme Hospital Ltd

Be advised, when visiting the hospital, you will need to bring;

1. Copy of ID/Passport, address, postal code and place of residence.
2. Copy of health care incl. phone number.
3. notarized power of attorney for an athlete under 18 years old if travel without parents.

Important to remember!

- If it is necessary to go the hospital because of injuries, please report first to the medical team of the organisation. If the medical team of the organization is not available anymore, please inform them afterwards. We would like to prevent people going to the hospital unnecessarily and to regulate the number of people visiting the hospital.
- **Attention:** Restriction on who can go: Rider plus 1 other. If it is necessary to go the hospital, please note that only 1 extra person (per day) is allowed to join the injured person.
