BRIEF PRESENTATION

Dear Presidents,
Dear Manager Board Members,

My name is Fabrizio Cazzola, born on May 21, 1985, in Conegliano, Treviso. I am the European Sales Manager for Stardue SRL, which owns the brands Basso Bikes Road, gravel bike, and LeeCougan MTB and E-MTB. I am married to Lucia, who has a child named Francesco. I began cycling in 1996 at age 11 with UC La Vallata, category G5, and changed teams in 1998 to SC Campolongo ESSE85, where I raced until 2003. That year, I won the International road race GP Sportivi Sovilla. From 2004 to 2006, I raced with Veloce Club Orsago in the under23 category, in 2007 with Bata Moser, and from 2008 to 2009 with GS Spersenigo, developing to Saunier Duval.

After university, I ended my competitive cycling career and began coaching young cyclists while attending the Federciclismo technical school, achieving the second FCI level. From 2012 to 2021, I was the president of ASD Sprint Vidor La Vallata, managing approximately 70 young athletes. I learned to manage the club both financially and organizationally, familiarizing myself with all FCI regulations. During the 2016-2020 Olympic period, I served as president of the Youth Commission of the Italian Cycling Federation, where I worked on improving Italian youth cycling, centered around skill development and promoting cycling among youth. We enhanced the national youth meeting and introduced the national CONI trophy. I created the Abilità Italia project.

In the 2021-2024 Olympic period, I was a member of Italian Cycling Federation Board Management, focusing on youth and Paralympic cycling. I collaborated with the youth commission to enhance and continue the projects initiated during the previous four-year term, aiming to build upon the accomplishments of 2016-2020. In the Paralympic cycling arena, I was introduced to a new discipline, where I deepened my understanding of the regulations concerning disability and further developed my cycling expertise.

One of the highlights of my career was orchestrating the 2022 Conegliano-Valdobbiadene national youth meeting, a four-day competition with approximately 2,500 participants in MTB, skills, and road races. This event required three years of planning, involving intricate economic and political coordination.

In 2023, alongside Pedali di Marca and Ciclistica Provinciale di Treviso, we managed to organize the UCI Gravel World Championships in Pieve di Soligo in just 28 days. This task was an immense, complex, and exhilarating challenge, culminating in a successful event managed under tight deadlines. I personally handled institutional relations with the Veneto region and managed the financial aspects of sponsorships, bringing together 1,200 athletes for two days of racing.

I hope to be elected as a member of the UEC Management Board, where I can leverage my experience and dedication to further contribute to the growth and excellence of cycling at the European level.
