2025 UEC Congress

Dear Presidents,

Further to our correspondence dated 8 December 2024, we would like to illustrate the various electoral procedures planned at the next 2025 UEC Congress.

In accordance with the articles 13-14-15 of the UEC Constitution and the UCI Constitution, the UEC Management Board is proposing the elections to be carried out by electronic vote (on site only) as follows:

- a. Election of the UEC President**
- b. Election of six (6) other UEC Management Board members**
Break – checking of votes and announcement of results
- c. Election of the fifteen (15) voting delegates and (8) substitute voting delegates for the UCI Congress.**

NB: the eight (8) UEC substitute voting delegates will be elected at the same time as the incumbents. The fifteen (15) candidates who have obtained the most votes will be appointed «voting delegates» and the eight (8) following candidates will be appointed «substitute voting delegates».

- d. Election of the external auditor of UEC accounts**

*NB: in accordance with Article 13, point 12 – UEC Constitution:
d) from paragraph 1 of the present article. Once he/she is elected, any application of a candidate in another election is declared null and void. If they are not elected, candidates may take part in the next election, provided that they have also applied for this election and have not withdrawn it from the EVCM.*

- e. Election of the 10 European candidates for the UCI Management Committee**

Break – checking of votes and announcement of results

UEC Constitution

Article 13

2. The candidates for the positions mentioned in b), c) (and d) if the auditor is not external) of paragraph 1 of the present article must be proposed by the federation of the nationality of the candidate or, provided they have the nationality of a UEC member federation, by that which issued his/her licence. They must also hold a licence since at least one year prior to the elections for which they are candidate, issued by the federation of their country of residence which must be a country member of the UEC. Furthermore, candidates for the position of auditor must have recognised qualifications in accountancy. The applications must be sent to the UEC headquarters, addressed to the electoral and voting monitoring commission (EVMC), by post or e-mail, at least thirty (30) days before the Congress. "

3. The following may apply for the position of UEC President:

- a) The outgoing President;
- b) Anyone whose application is put forward by the federation of the candidate's nationality or, provided they have the nationality of an UEC member federation, by that which issued his/her licence;
- c) Individuals whose application has been put forward by at least three (3) UEC member federations, provided that they have the nationality of a UEC member federation. "

+ copy of passport for every candidate

Presentation of the candidates

The submission of candidatures for the UEC Presidency and the UEC Management Board shall be sent along with a curriculum vitae, a brief presentation of the candidate not exceeding two pages and a copy of their 2024 and 2025 licences;

The submission of candidatures for the voting delegates and substitute voting delegates for the UCI Congress shall be sent along with a copy of their 2024 and 2025 licences;

The submission of candidatures for the UCI Management Committee shall be sent along with a curriculum vitae, a brief presentation of the candidate not exceeding two pages, a copy of their passport and 2024 licence (art. 52 UCI Constitution).

7 February 2025 (23:59 CET)
