Remarks

- Timing transponders will be handed out together with start numbers and must be returned immediately after the race at the tent located near the finish line.
- At the time of the riders' confirmation, Nationals Teams Team Managers must present their national outfit to the commissaires.
- Race numbers must be collected at the time stated in the Championships programme. Riders' licences and passports must be submitted to the commissaires panel.
- rider shall ensure that their identification number is visible and legible at all times. The identification number shall be well fixed and may not be folded or altered.

8. RACE SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL RULES

1.1 The 2025 UEC MTB Marathon European Championships are organised by the Union Européenne de Cyclisme (UEC) in cooperation with Genoa Bike ASD

Race director (DOF): Massimiliano Atramento

- **1.2** The event will be organised in accordance with rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.
- **1.3** The UEC MTB Marathon European Championships consist of the following races:
 - MTB Marathon (XCM) on 8 June 2025.

ARTICLE 2. – TYPE OF EVENT

- **2.1** The event is open to athletes in the following categories:
 - ✓ MTB Marathon Men Elite
 - ✓ MTB Marathon Women Elite
 - MTB Marathon Masters Men Aged: 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 / 50-54 / 55-59 / 60-64 / 65-69 / 70-74 / 75+
 - MTB Marathon Masters Women
 Aged: 35-39 / 40-44 / 45-49 / 50-54 / 55-59 / 60+
- **2.2** It is entered on the UCI calendar as a Continental Championships event (CC) and Masters Continental Championships (CCM)
- **2.3** The following final classifications will be produced for:
 - ✓ Men Elite*
 - ✓ Women Elite*
 - ✓ All Masters categories*

*The 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony.





ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

3.1 National Teams

➡ Elite riders only

National Federations may enter the following riders per Championship free of charge:

✓ Women Elite – max. 2 riders

✓ Men Elite – max. 2 riders

If National teams have more than 2 riders (WE/ME), point 3.2 below applies = registration is due.

Registration applies to riders, staff and NF Official Delegates

Riders must compete in their national jersey.

3.2 Other riders

ELITE Individuals (not members of the "National Team")

⇒ MASTERS *

In accordance with the UCI regulations, the participation is open for <u>European riders</u> only with an annual licence issued by a National Federation affiliated to the UCI.

- * The attention of all registered participants in the MASTERS categories is drawn to the importance, before registration and also before presenting themselves at the licence check, of checking that they meet the requirements defined by the UCI for participating in events on the UCI international masters calendar"
- * 4.1.009 All riders aged 35 or over who hold a masters licence are allowed to ride mountain bike events on the UCI international masters calendar, apart from:
 - 1. riders who, during the current season starting January 1st, have scored 1 or more UCI points during the same calendar year as a UCI masters event;
 - 2. riders who during the current year have been a member of a team registered with the UCI. (text modified on 1.01.18; 1.01.20, 1.01.21)

3.3 Start order

The start order will be made according to the UCI/UEC regulations.

The riders line up in the order in which they are to be called to the start line.

The number of riders on each line is decided by the President of the Commissaires' panel and supervised by a commissaire. The rider himself decides which position on the line to take.

3.4 Start grid

➡ ELITE RIDERS

The start grid will be determined according to the UCI MTB Regulations article 4.02.061 as follows:

- 1. as per the last published UCI XCM individual ranking
- 2. as per the last published UCI XCO individual ranking
- 3. unclassified riders: by drawing lots

3.5 Start grid

➡ MASTERS RIDERS

The start order for all <u>Masters categories</u> will be as follows:

- 1. defending European champion 2024 of the categories concerned, younger categories first
- 2. according to the order of the on-line registration

ARTICLE 4. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

The following UCI Regulations will be applicable:

4.2.038 Staff working for riders must wear readily identifiable team clothing.





4.2.040 For the Olympic Games, world championships, world cup events and continental championships nobody may enter a feed/technical assistance zone without accreditation.

For world cup events season long accreditations issued to the UCI ELITE MTB TEAMS and UCI MTB TEAMS by the UCI. For the national federations or individual riders passes are prepared by the organiser and handed out at registration: they obtain 1 accreditation per registered rider per zone. Note that for a double feed/technical assistance zone they only obtain 1 accreditation per registered rider.

- 4.2.044 No rider may turn back on the course to reach a feed/technical assistance zone. Any rider doing so is disqualified. Only within the feed/technical assistance zone itself, a rider may turn back without obstructing other competitors.
- 4.2.045 Technical assistance during a race is permitted subject to the conditions below.
- 4.2.046 Authorised technical assistance during a race consists of repairs to or the replacement of any part of the bicycle other than the frame.

Bike changes are not permitted, and the rider must cross the finishing line with the same handlebar number plate that he/she had at the start.

- 4.2.047 Technical assistance can only be given in the feed/technical assistance zones.
- 4.2.048 Spare equipment and tools for repairs must be kept in these zones. Repairs and equipment changes can be carried out by the rider himself or with the help of a teammate, team mechanic or neutral technical assistance.
- 4.2.049 In addition to technical assistance in feed zones, technical assistance is permitted outside these zones only between riders who are members of the same UCI ELITE MTB team, UCI MTB team or of the same national team / nation.

Riders may carry tools and spare parts provided that these do not involve any danger to the rider himself or the other competitors.

ARTICLE 5. AWARDS CEREMONIES

In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 1.2.113 of the UCI Regulations, the 3 best riders of each category must attend the official awards ceremony, any interviews organised and the press conference.

Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing.

Riders must present themselves at the podium in a maximum of 10 minutes after crossing the finish line.

ARTICLE 6. ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations and the specific Italian laws are entirely applicable to the event.

ARTICLE 7. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 8. RESPONSIBILITIES

The organiser and UEC will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organiser and UEC decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and UEC officials.


